GOVERNING BOARD CONSTITUTION

On December 1st 2014 Cheadle Heath Primary new Governing Board met for the first time following reconstitution.

A new Chair and Vice Chair were appointed and a number of new co-opted Governors. Under the reconstruction there are 12 governors on the school's Governing Board made up of:

- Headteacher
- 3 Parent Governors
- 1 Local Authority Governor
- 1 staff Governor
- 6 co-opted Governors

In autumn term 2020 we amended the committee structures and moved to holding two full Governing Board meetings per term. The various elements from previous committees - including finance, teaching / learning / assessment and pupil support - are now incorporated into the two full board meetings.
