

Sunset Club Reminder

Due to the popularity of Sunset Club, booking is essential. If children attend Sunset Club without prior booking then we are understaffed and do not have sufficient food provisions. We plan our staffing ratios, which are dependent on the children's ages, in advance to ensure the safety of the children. If you are using Sunset Club it is essential that you book for each week by the Friday deadline of 1pm. The 6pm bookings are usually full so if you need 6pm please book early. Pre booking is for the safety and enjoyment of our children as we are proud of the high quality provision we have developed and do not want to compromise this. Thank you for your understanding.

Attendance Reminder

As previously mentioned, we automatically send out letters to parents and carers if children aren't able to attend school and their attendance is declining, even if the absence is authorised by school. Monitoring attendance is essential for us to comply with the latest government stipulations. We understand that attendance letters may cause anxiety so please do come and speak to us if you need to understand this better so that we can support you with your child's attendance.

Confused about the different ways we communicate to parents? See the list below for clarification:

School Spider is our home – school correspondence system. Our school website contains lots of useful information and forms.

Under 'Parent Information' you will find information about admissions as well as 'Meet the Staff'. Under the School Office tab you will find Term Dates, Leave of Absence Form, school lunch information and menus and school uniform details.

School Spider

In addition to the website, you can also download the 'School Spider' app (select Cheadle Heath Primary School) to give you quick access to the newsletters, school calendar and parent login which we use for Parents Evenings and surveys.

As a cashless school, all of our payments for trips, events and booking Sunrise & Sunset club are made on School Spider under Bookings and Payments.

Our school meals are provided by Dolce. School Grid is their online ordering and payment website which enables you to preorder your child's meals in advance and arrange payment directly to Dolce where necessary. All children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 benefit from Universal Free School meals, so please take advantage of this by encouraging your child to try our school meals service.
