## Ramadan and Eid

We have been discussing the importance of Ramadan, a sacred and meaningful time for millions around the world. Ramadan is the ninth month of the Islamic lunar calendar and holds great significance for our Muslim families and community members. We know that some of our children want to fast during this time. As with previous years, we remind parents / carers that our advice from local faith groups and the SACRE board is that children in Y5 and Y6 may be able to fast during school hours. We have guidelines around this important subject and have communicated this again to parents. If your child is partaking we request that you return a signed agreement form to the school office. We authorise one day absence for Eid. ## Parents' Evening Reminder

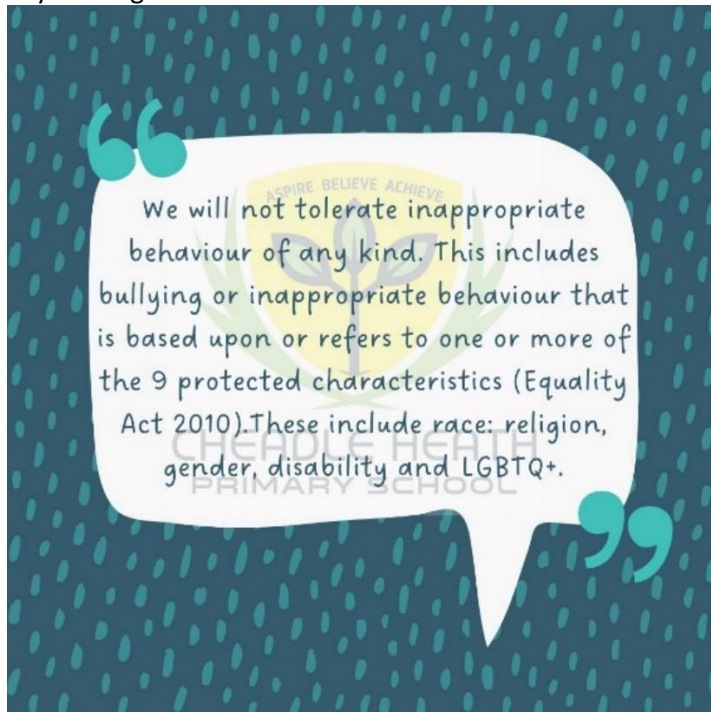
## On time, all day, every day

## Testing Times

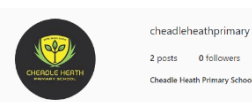
